For he spake, and it was done; he commanded, and it stood fast.

The Lord bringeth the counsel of the heathen to nought:

He maketh the devices of the people of none effect.

D/F# G Em A G D

The counsel of the Lord standeth for ever, the thoughts of his heart to all generations.

*Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord; and the people whom he hath chosen*

*For his own inheritance. The Lord looketh from heaven; he beholdeth all the sons of men.*

D G D G D/F#

From the place of his habitation he looketh upon all the inhabitants of the earth.

G Em A

He fashioneth their hearts alike; he considereth all their works.

D G D G D/F# G

There is no king saved by the multitude of an host: a mighty man is not delivered by much strength.

Em A G D

An horse is a vain thing for safety: neither shall he deliver any by his great strength.

A G A G D

*Behold, the eye of the Lord is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy;*

A G A G D

*To deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine. Our soul waiteth for the Lord:*

He is our help and our shield. For our heart shall rejoice in him,

D/F# G Em A

Because we have trusted in his holy name.

Let thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us, according as we hope in thee.
