The WAMI Charity

The WAMI organization is a non-profit corporation. Proceeds from each annual awards program are given to a charitable cause voted on each year by the WAMI Board of Directors. The recipient of the 1988 WAMI Charity is:

Very Special Arts of Wisconsin. This volunteer organization was created to allow disabled children and adults an opportunity to experience all forms of art including dance, music, visual arts, drama and literature. Founded in 1975 by Jean Kennedy Smith, the handicapped are able to participate in classes as well as local, district, and state festivals. It is Very Special Arts' intention to challenge the disabled and to help them to enter the mainstream of cultural and educational life.

A WAMI History

The WAMI's were founded in 1980 by Mr. Ted Curro, a club owner and avid supporter of local music. In 1986, a volunteer Board of Directors was assembled to take on the growing task of promoting the WAMI's and to produce the annual awards program. That same year, the WAMI Academy was formed. Since that time, membership in the WAMI Academy has grown to more than 500 music industry professionals. The WAMI's operate as a non-profit organization with no paid staff.
